Dear Residents, Family Members, Staff, Volunteers and Friends,

The impact of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) has reached most areas of the world, including our local region. The Pine Run Health Center has been dedicated to protecting the health and well-being of our Residents and Associates.

With everyone's health and safety in mind, we have amended our Visitation Policy for Long Term Residents as follows:

- Visiting hours will be Sun – Sat between 1pm – 5pm
- All inside visits must be scheduled via the following link:

- All indoor visits will be in the Chapel on the main floor
- Check in with the front desk when you arrive, they will contact the unit to have your loved one brought to the chapel
- No visitors are permitted on the units (except those with loved ones on hospice)
- Visits will be limited to 30 minutes, if you arrive early please wait in the lobby area
- The Cottonwood Café is for employees only, no visitations will be permitted in this area
- Outdoor visitation is encouraged on the 2nd floor patio, under the canopy weather permitted
- All visitors are required to wear face masks during their entire visits
- Maintain social distancing and follow infection control protocols
- No Children under the age of 12 will be permitted to visit
- Residents are limited to 2 visitors at a time while in the building, a limit of 4 visitors when visiting outside
- All visitors must sign in and out when entering & exiting the health center
