RE: COVID Rates Rising in Bucks County



COVID-19 rates in Pennsylvania – and Bucks County, in particular – are skyrocketing. Three weeks ago, we were at 3.9%; last week, 6.2%; and **today, we are at 9.5%**. We are working hard to balance your mental health and keep you safe. We know that 2020 has been incredibly trying and emotionally draining.

Currently, there will be no lockdown of the Ferry Road Campus. However, on Monday, November 16, we will re-implement some safety guidelines to keep you – and our Associates – safe.

- ❖ We will suspend eating in the Bar and Grille. Please adhere to your cluster’s pick-up schedule (unless you have made alternate arrangements with Dining Services).
- ❖ We will suspend the Open Bar on Tuesday nights.
- ❖ We will reduce gatherings of Villagers and staff to 25 or less (including Keep on Learning, Thursday Night Program, weekend movies, and other Villager activities).
- ❖ Please wear your mask when you leave your home; observe social distancing guidelines (stay at least six-feet apart); and wash your hands frequently.
- ❖ Please don a mask when a Pine Run Associate comes to your door, and socially distance from Housekeepers and other staff while they are working in your home.
- ❖ Please continue to observe all safety protocols in the Pool and Fitness Center.

We need your help in maintaining a safe campus for your friends and neighbors and our Associates. There is no way to know what will happen next, but we do know that the infection rates continue to rise.
