Re: COVID-19 Updates: Positive Result in Skilled Nursing

This notification is to inform you that, on November 18th as part of our Universal Testing program, we learned one of our Associates in skilled nursing tested positive for COVID-19. Although this potential exposure is not at The Garden, we are implementing measures to protect our residents.

- This Associate has been diligently wearing a mask while at work and is currently asymptomatic.
- Per The Department of Health and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidelines, the Associate will self-quarantine before they can return to work.
- Unfortunately, no visits will be permitted until we have 14 consecutive days without a positive COVID-19 test result.
- We continue to actively monitor our Residents for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and all residents will be screened for COVID-19.
- All of our Associates continue to follow public health recommendations to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19. These include strict handwashing procedures, wearing face masks, and wearing gloves when interacting with Residents. All associates are also being tested for COVID-19.

The Garden Team will continue to work diligently to do all we can to keep this virus at bay, and I will continue to inform you of any additional information I receive.
