RE: **Village Reopening to Visitors Friday, February 26, 2021**

Effective Friday, February 12, 2021, we will have vaccinated 98% of Villagers and 77% of Associates for COVID-19. Effective Friday, February 26, those vaccinated will have 95% protection against severe symptoms if infected.

The Village will reopen to visitors on Friday, February 26 for your families and friends to visit in your homes. (They will not be permitted into any of our common areas, including the Community Center, Yellowwood Inn, and Pine Run Inn.) Please continue to socially distance and wear masks during your visits. The majority of your family members and friends have likely not yet been vaccinated. All of us will need to continue to wear masks, socially distance, wash hands, etc., well into this year.

For now:

- ❖ As the Governor has not made recent changes to dining guidelines, please continue to come to the Grille to pick up your meals (this has not changed).
- ❖ Maintenance and Grounds will continue regular upkeep of the Community, including cluster maintenance and work orders. Please be sure to wear your masks and socially distance when our Associates are working in your homes.
- ❖ Housekeeping will continue its regular schedule (except for those Villagers who are self-quarantining in their homes). Please be sure to wear your masks and socially distance when our Associates are working in your homes.
- ❖ Per Governor Wolf's mandate (still in place), if you travel out of state for any reason, you must notify Special Care at Ext. 5181 and self-quarantine (not leave your home) for 10 days upon your return; OR, you can self-quarantine for 72 hours, and then get a COVID test. If that test is negative, you may leave your cottage; if it is positive, you must remain in your cottage for the full 10 days of quarantine.

(OVER, PLEASE)

- ❖ If you leave the Ferry Road Campus, either overnight or for an extended duration, please obtain an “Away Form” from our Concierge. Complete the information, and return it to the Concierge prior to your departure (this has not changed).
- ❖ The Health Center, Garden, and Lakeview remain closed to visitors.
- ❖ There will be no change in Gate House procedures for now.
