<p>Dining:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Communal Dining is limited to Residents unexposed to COVID-19 • Residents may eat in Dining Room, Private Dining Room and Courtyard Café limiting 2 persons per table and tables are spaced 6 feet apart • Hand sanitizer is provided upon entering and exiting for meal time • Two rolling seating’s are provided to ensure staggered arrival and departure times, limiting the number of people in the Dining Room and ensuring social distancing. • Breakfast is open seating 7:45 am – 9:45 am • 1st seating Lunch 11:30am – 12:30pm // Dinner 4:30pm – 5:30pm • 2nd seating Lunch 12:45pm – 1:45pm // Dinner 5:45pm – 6:45pm • Infection Control Precautions are in effect 	<p>Currently in effect 3/15/21</p>
<p>Life Enrichment:</p>	<p>Limited activities with no more than 10 Residents unexposed to COVID-19:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social distancing is maintained • Hand washing / Hand sanitizer is mandatory • Universal masking is required by Residents and Associates • Small group activities will be held in the activity room, TV Lounge, Family room and outside on the porch weather permitting • After all activities the chairs and room will be disinfected per infection control precautions 	<p>Currently in effect</p>

Non-Essential Personnel:	<p>Guests, Contractors and Vendors :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anyone entering the facility are screened in the lobby by the Concierge (Dining Vendors are screened in the kitchen) • Screening will take place prior to work • Universal masking is mandatory • All questions about symptoms are asked during screening process 	Currently in effect
Beauty Parlor:	<p>Residents unexposed to COVID-19 will be permitted to utilize the salon:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Negative COVID-19 test of Beautician • Beautician and Residents will wear masks at all times • 2 Residents are permitted in the salon at a time • Proper cleaning and disinfecting will occur between Residents 	Currently in effect
Volunteer's:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Volunteers will be screened upon arrival • Universal Masking is mandatory • All questions about symptoms are asked during screening process 	Currently in effect
Visitation:	<p>Skype, Zoom and Face Time Calls are available:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Life Enrichment will set up Residents to have a private conversation with their Family and /or Friends <p>Communication Window visits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Families and Friends may set up a Communication Window visit through the Concierge. 1st floor by our Gazebo and The Arbor both have communication windows available <p>Conference Room Visits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Family and Friends may set up a Conference Room visit by calling the Concierge. <p>In-room visits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Family and friends may setup in room visits by scheduling with the Concierge. Outings:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All outings are restricted 	Currently in effect
Healthcare personnel / Medical appointments:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medical Personnel entering Lakeview must be screened by the Concierge upon arrival • Medical appointments are available by telehealth, in person at LV or in the PCP / specialists office • All Residents going out for Medical Appointments will wear a face mask as provided 	Currently in effect
Staff Screening:	<p>All staff entering the building are screened prior to and after shift:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temperature check beginning and ending of the shift • Screening questions are answered • Universal face masking is required 	Currently in effect

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Face Shields are required while care is provided, meals are being served and if in close contact with a Resident 	
Resident Screening:	<p>All Residents are screened twice daily:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temperature checks are performed twice daily • Blood Oxygen levels are obtained twice daily • Staff will monitor all Residents for other signs and symptoms and will report any concerns to physician 	Currently in effect
Universal Testing:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Associates will be tested Monthly due to the decrease in Buck's County's positivity rate. • Any Resident who goes out for a medical appointment will quarantine for 4 days, on Day 4 an Antigen test will be done. Results are within 15 minutes. • County Positivity Rate <5%: Routine testing for Asymptomatic Residents is not recommended. Routine Testing for Asymptomatic Associates is encourage every 4-6 weeks. • County Positivity Rate 5% to 10%: Weekly testing is encouraged of all Residents with outside contact in the last 14 days, if they have not otherwise been tested during that period. Repeat Testing for Asymptomatic Associates is encourage every 30 days. • County Positivity Rate >10%: Weekly testing is encouraged of all Residents with outside contact in the last 14 days, if they have not otherwise been tested during that period. Remaining plans unchanged:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Positive COVID-19 cases will be evaluated for most appropriate care level based on symptoms and behaviors that may compromise safety of others. Options include isolating at LV if no signs and symptoms, transferring to Pine Run Health Center's COVID-19 isolation unit if Resident has signs and symptoms or transfer to Doylestown Hospital if appropriate. • Symptomatic staff and Residents will be COVID-19 tested as needed • All staff continue to follow infection control practices and wear required, appropriate PPE 	Currently in effect
