Re: COVID-19 Updates: Positive Result

The community at large is seeing wide-spread incidence of COVID. This memo is to inform you that, on April 6, 2021, we received results that a Garden Associate tested positive for COVID-19.

- This Associate has been diligently wearing a mask while at work and has not worked since Wednesday, March 31, 2021.
- We will follow guidance of The Bucks County Department of Health and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for when the Associate can return to work.
- We will provide all meals in the Residents' rooms. Group activities have stopped and one on one visits will be provided.
- Visitors will not be permitted until we have received results of outbreak testing being completed on all residents and associates as negative or if another positive case is identified, not until 14 consecutive days without a positive COVID-19 test result.
- We continue to actively monitor our Residents for signs and symptoms of COVID-19, and all Residents will be screened for COVID-19 weekly.
- All of our Associates continue to follow public health recommendations to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19. These include strict handwashing procedures, wearing face masks and face shields, and wearing gloves when interacting with Residents and wearing gowns as indicated.
- Universal testing of All Associates for COVID-19 continues.

While the prevalence of COVID-19 is not unique to The Garden, our team will continue to work diligently to do all we can to keep this virus at bay, and I will continue to inform you of any additional information I receive.
